



# ENSURE360 LOCATOR

The Ensure360<sup>SM</sup> Locator is the backbone of the location feature. With an appropriate number of Locators in each area, the Ensure360 platform can use them to receive location data sent out by the Pendant. The Locator then passes data back to the Headend, where it will determine the Pendant's location. After installation, the Locator does not require any user interaction to work; it just needs to be plugged in.

For living areas such as resident apartments, one Locator should be used in each room where location is desired to be identified. For example, if it is desired to know whether a resident is in their bedroom versus their bathroom, the apartment will need two Locators, one in each room.

For larger areas such as common areas, a Locator can detect devices within a 30' radius. It is likely that more than one will be needed to cover larger areas like dining or activity rooms.

#### Installation Instructions

- 1. Remove Locator from box
- 2. Remove outlet cover screw
- 3. Plug in Locator
- Reinstall outlet cover screw through Locator
